#### **SAFETY WARNINGS**

Read all instructions carefully before you use the Milk Frother and retain the Instruction Manual in a safe place for future reference. Misuse of the D053 Milk Frother could void the warranty conditions.



**IMPORTANT:** DO NOT IMMERSE the base or the milk jug in water or any other liquid. DO NOT WASH any parts in the dishwasher. Doing so will permanently damage the appliance and void the warranty.



#### WARNING:

- Before connecting the appliance to the power supply, check if the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds with the voltage in your home.
- Only connect the appliance to an earthed wall socket.
- Always disconnect the appliance from the mains if you leave the appliance unattended and before you assemble, disassemble or clean it.
- Do not use the appliance if the plug, power cord or any other parts are damaged. If the plug or power cord is damaged in any manner, return the appliance to your store of purchase or contact the Caffitaly System Customer Service Line on AU 02 9846 0307 I
   NZ 0800 450 894. Do not attempt to repair the appliance yourself as this will void your warranty.
- Do not let the power cord hang over the edge of the surface on which the appliance stands.
- Always place the base and the milk jug on a dry, flat and stable surface.
- Always operate the appliance with the lid firmly in place.
- Do not let any water come into contact with the connectors on the power base and underneath the milk jug. Always ensure these areas are completely dry before use.
- Do not spill any liquid on the connectors. If you do, unplug appliance immediately and dry completely. Always ensure these areas are completely dry before use.
- The heating element surface is subject to residual heat after use. DO NOT TOUCH!
- Only use the appliance to heat or froth milk. Do not use it to process any other ingredients.
- Do not overfill the jug with milk past the maximum capacity indicated for frothing and heating as the milk could overflow and cause scalding or electrical issues.
- Do not move the appliance while it is in operation and never leave the appliance unattended while in operation.

#### **SAFETY WARNINGS - Continued**

- Do not place the appliance on a hot surface and prevent the power cord from coming into contact with hot surfaces.
- Only use the appliance in combination with its original base and accessories. Never use
  accessories or parts from other manufacturers. Use of such accessories or parts not
  supplied by the manufacturer or Roasting Australia Holding Pty Limited will void your
  warranty.
- Do not use the appliance in combination with a transformer, as this could have hazardous results.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental
  capabilities, lack of experience and knowledge, unless properly supervised by a person
  responsible for their safety.
- Children should not operate, play with or near the appliance.
- Keep the appliance and its power cord out of the reach of children.

- Ensure you clean the appliance thoroughly after every use. See Page 11 for full cleaning instructions.
- Make sure that the appliance has been switched off before you remove the milk jug from the base.
- Never use scouring pads, abrasive cleaning agents or aggressive liquids such as petrol or acetone to clean the appliance.

This appliance is intended for **Domestic use only**. It is not intended for use in environments such as staff kitchens, shops, offices, farms or other work environments, nor is it intended to be used by clients in hotels, motels, bed and breakfasts and other nonresidential environments.

## **MACHINE COMPONENTS**



#### GETTING TO KNOW YOUR MILK FROTHER

#### The D053 Milk Frother can be used for the following functions separately:



## Frothing and Heating Milk



Heating Milk Only

Before using your Milk Frother, clean all parts according to the section 'Cleaning and Maintenance' on Page 11.



**IMPORTANT:** DO NOT IMMERSE the base or the milk jug in water or any other liquid. DO NOT WASH any parts in the dishwasher. Doing so will permanently damage the appliance and void the warranty.



The Milk Frother is equipped with following accessories: (Refer to diagram on Page 5)

- SPINDLE this is used to hold the Magnetic Whisk Holder for heating milk.
- MAGNETIC WHISK HOLDER this is placed into the Spindle for heating milk.
- COIL WHISK this is placed around the Magnetic Whisk Holder and then placed into the Spindle for frothing milk.

#### WHEN NOT IN USE: PLEASE KEEP YOUR ACCESSORIES IN A SAFE PLACE.

#### The accessories to use for:

Frothing Milk

- Spindle, Magnetic Whisk Holder and the Coil Whisk.
- Heating Milk Only
- Spindle and Magnetic Whisk Holder only.





#### NOTE:

Frothing Milk – the minimum capacity is 100ml, the maximum capacity is 150ml. Heating Milk – the minimum capacity is 100ml, the maximum capacity is 250ml.

## **BEFORE THE FIRST USE**

Ensure you have all the accessories listed on Page 5. The Spindle should already be assembled for Frothing: i.e. the Coil Whisk will be around the Magnetic Whisk Holder which will be sitting within the Spindle. If this is not the case, please check the packaging to ensure it has not fallen out during transit.


Wash the lid and spindle parts in warm soapy water and dry thoroughly. Wipe interior and exterior of appliance with a soft damp cloth and dry thoroughly.

## **HOW TO ASSEMBLE ACCESSORIES FOR FROTHING**






Gently place the Coil Whisk onto the Magnetic Whisk Holder



Slot the Magnetic Whisk Holder with the attached Coil Whisk into the Spindle.



Place the completed frothing Spindle into the jug; you will feel a slight magnetic pull.



BARISTA TIP: This setting is perfect to create froth for drinks such as cappuccino, mocha and hot chocolate.

Use cold skim milk for best results.

## FROTHING AND HEATING MILK



Do not leave the Milk Frother unsupervised when it is in operation. Do not touch any part of the interior of the jug while it is in use as it can cause scalding or burns.



**IMPORTANT:** For Heating and Frothing Milk -


the Minimum capacity is 100 ml, and the Maximum capacity is 150 ml.

## FROTHING AND HEATING MILK - Continued





Place the Milk Frother on a flat surface.



Place the assembled Spindle into the jug (if not in position already). You will feel a magnetic pull attaching the Spindle to the jug.



Add your milk to the jug until it reaches the 'Maximum Froth Line' - 150ml.



#### WARNING:

Don't overfill the jug with milk when frothing as the milk could overflow – risk of scalding and electrical issues.



Switch the Milk Frother on at the Power Point and press the Power Button. It will light up Red.



When the heating and frothing is complete, the Milk Frother will automatically stop. Approx. 2 ½ minutes.






#### MAINTENANCE TIP:

Please pour the milk and the froth from the jug. **DO NOT** use metal spoons or other sharp implements as you may damage the non-stick coating of the inner jug and in doing so void the warranty.



#### WARNING:

Wait for the appliance to cool down between uses and before cleaning.





## HOW TO ASSEMBLE ACCESSORIES FOR HEATING <






Gently remove the Coil Whisk from the Magnetic Whisk Holder.



Slot the Magnetic Whisk Holder back into the Spindle.



Place the completed heating Spindle into the jug; you will feel a slight magnetic pull.



BARISTA TIP: This setting is perfect to create heated milk for drinks such as flat whites, caffé lattes and caramelattes.

Use cold skim milk for best results.

## HEATING MILK ONLY <=>=



Do not leave the Milk Frother unsupervised when it is in operation. Do not touch any part of the interior of the jug while it is in use as it can cause scalds or burns.



IMPORTANT: For Heating Milk Only - the minimum capacity is 100ml, the maximum capacity is 250ml.




NOTE: The milk frother is designed to heat and froth milk ONLY.

## HEATING MILK ONLY - Continued <>>



Place the Milk Frother on a flat surface.



Place the assembled Spindle into the jug (if not in position already). You will feel a magnetic pull attaching the Spindle to the jug.



You can add milk to the jug up to the 'Maximum Heating Line' -250ml.




#### WARNING:

Don't overfill the jug as the milk could overflow – risk of scalding and electrical issues.



Switch the Milk Frother on at the Power Point and press the Power Button. It will light up Red.



When the heating is complete, the Milk Frother will automatically stop. Approx. 3 minutes.





#### MAINTENANCE TIP:


Please pour the milk from the jug.

**DO NOT** use metal spoons or other sharp implements as you may damage the non-stick coating of the inner jug and in doing so void the warranty.






- 1. Before cleaning, switch off the Milk Frother from the Power Point and unplug.
- 2. Use a soft cloth only.
- 3. Do not use any abrasive materials or detergents to clean the inside of the jug.
- 4. Wipe interior with a damp cloth **AFTER** the appliance has cooled.
- 5. Clean the appliance again thoroughly if the machine hasn't been used for a period of time.





## **CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS... Continued**



Remove the lid from the Milk Jug, take out the Spindle and separate the Coil Whisk from the Magnetic Whisk Holder.



Rinse the lid, Coil Whisk, Magnetic Whisk Holder and Spindle with warm water and mild detergent to remove all traces of milk



Wipe the inside of the jug with a soft damp cloth to ensure all traces of milk are removed paying special attention to Min / Max Lines.



#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

Failure to remove all the milk residue will result in burnt milk adhering to the jug which will affect the performance of the Milk Frother.



Clean the outside of the appliance with a soft damp cloth. Do not use any abrasive materials or detergents.




Wipe the unplugged Power Base of the appliance with a soft damp cloth. Dry completely.



#### WARNING:

Do not immerse the milk jug or power base into water or any other liquid.



#### WARNING:

Do not place any part of the milk frother into the dishwasher.





#### MAINTENANCE TIP:

If some milk residue is left on the bottom of the jug even after cleaning, leave warm soapy water in the jug to soak for 1-2 hours. Then wipe out again with a soft damp cloth and dry completely before storage.

### WARRANTY DETAILS

Dear Customer.

Thank you for buying this product. This Machine has been designed and produced using the best technologies available.

#### 1. Warranty Details:

- (a) If your Caffitaly System Machine develops a fault or defect during the warranty period, and subject to the terms below, we will repair it or replace it.
- (b) We offer this warranty on top of any guarantees imposed by the Australian Competition and Consumer Act 2010 and any other applicable State or Territory legislation (if your product was purchased in Australia) and the New Zealand Consumers Guarantees Act (if your product was purchased in New Zealand).
- (c) The warranty applies for 12 months from the date of purchase.
- (d) The warranty covers fault or defects in the product's materials or manufacturing.
- (e) The warranty does not cover:
- (f) Misuse, or use other than in accordance with the product's instructions;
- (a Negligence on your part;
- (h Normal wear and tear; or
- Faults or defects caused by third parties, including work done by unauthorised service or repair agents.

#### 2. Making a Warranty Claim

- (a) To make a claim you should first contact the Caffitaly System Customer Service Line by telephone on 02 9846 0307 in Australia or 0800 450 894 in New Zealand and we will be able to provide you with the appropriate next steps for service or replacement of your machine.
- Before contacting the Caffitaly System

- c) After you have initiated the claim via the telephone, we may ask you to return the product to us, as per the address details in Point 4.
- d) You will need to provide your receipt as proof of purchase in order to make a claim under the warranty.
- e) Once you return the product and lodged a claim to us, we will assess the claim and let you know whether it is covered. The decision whether to repair or replace a product

- is at our sole discretion unless there is a 'major failure' as defined in the Australian Consumer Law or New Zealand Consumers Guarantees Act.
- f) If it is covered we will deliver the repaired or replaced product back to you. We will bear this cost.
- g) If it is not covered, we will deliver the product back to you and you will bear the transport cost.
